


Weekly prayer points

- Pray for our ministers—Jonathan, Matthew and Peter that,

 home and now reside in Nursing homes. We think also of those
 living alone and often struggling to look after themselves
- Pray for those who have been bereaved in recent times. Help

 lives and not to linger on the difficult moments and that God
 will give them the strength to carry on and not to lose faith at
 this time.




